The focus of this course are the I-Thou encounters in the Book of Genesis and how these biblical characters, such as Adam and Eve, Cain, Abraham, Hagar and Tamar heard and responded to the Voice of God. Lectures are combined with a number of guided study tours in and around Jerusalem and the Negev desert.
